Main activity of the section: 6 streams of conferences.

Central Office has built up capacity to support the organisation of conferences. New staff member: Marian.

Report from the Executive Board of EFB: Financial situation of EFB has been stabilised, thanks to excellent effort by Karsten, supported by several ExBo members.

New Sections developing in EFB: Bioengineering and Bioprocessing (EBBS), Plant Biotechnology, Polymer Biotechnology.

New President: Mathias Uhlen.

EFB is a charity, not for profit. Therefore, surplus from conferences organised by the Microbial Physiology need to be re-invested into the benefit of biotechnology. It was proposed to instigate bursaries for some young biotechnologists from research groups that have supported Section meetings to attend the ECB2016 EFB Congress in Krakow next July.

Proposed is the supply of 10 scholarships of 250 € each.

(With preference to research groups that have been represented/have supported Section meetings.)

The proposal was approved unanimously.

5. Treasurer's report

- The current assets of the Section are €58,092, consisting of €46,909 in the bank and a repayment of €11,183 deposit paid for the hotel for the current RPP meeting. A further contribution will soon be received from the EFB Central office as our share of the surplus from the Section meeting entitled "Bacteria Electron Transfer and its Regulation" held in Vimeira, Portugal, in March.

There are currently few movements in the account. Conferences with upfront payments are supported.

The current RPP meeting expects t oresult in a low surplus. More students than expected attended, which is very good. As their registration is subsidised, this reduces the financial outcome – which conforms to the Sections policy.
