



The fifth edition of the Applied Synthetic Biology in Europe (ASBE V) conference was held online from 2 to 4 November 2020.

The event brought together 260 international scientists who exchanged perspectives, recent findings and emerging technologies within the field of synthetic biology.

A total of 34 oral presentations and 99 poster contributions covered a wide range of topics, including circuit design and implementation, enabling technologies for alternative feedstocks, and a variety of industrial applications.

The conference facilitated active interaction among participants, encouraging the exchange of ideas and the development of a shared vision for future advances in the discipline. The diversity of participants and the high scientific standard of the presentations contributed to stimulating discussions and fostered new collaborations.
